About Us

Nairn Community Transport (NCT) operates a fleet of fully accessible minibuses supporting local community groups and charities with their transport needs.

- Our service is community-focused and does not compete with private hire companies.
- We aim to make travel easier and more affordable for groups who might otherwise struggle to access transport.

How It Works

Driver Requirements

Each group must provide its own driver, who must be either:

- MiDAS trained – transferable to other community transport services.
- NCT Competency trained – specific to our minibuses.

If your group does not have a trained driver, we can help arrange training opportunities at Nairn Community & Arts Centre.

If you already have a qualified driver, we require:

- A copy of their training certificate
- A completed Driver Registration Form (for insurance purposes)

Other Key Information

- Nairn Community Transport has a fleet of three minibuses, and each have 16 passenger + driver capacity and fitted with a tail lift.
- Fuel Cards – provided in each vehicle, included in hire price.
- Mileage Recording – required at the start and end of each journey
- Payment – invoiced monthly, payable within 30 days (via BACS, cash, or cheque).
- Booking – New groups must complete an Affiliation Form; each hire also requires a Booking Form

Pricing

Effective from 1st May 2025

Type of Hire	Pricing
Standard Hire	£1 per kilometre
Minimum Hire Charge	£20 per hire
Longer Hires	First 150 km at £1/km, additional distance at £0.80/km
Multi-Day Hires	£1/km (first 150 km), £0.80/km thereafter, with a minimum average of £100 per day

Insurance Policy (Drivers)

- Minimum driver age: 25
- Must have held a valid licence for at least 2 years
- No upper age limit
- No additional charges for notifiable incidents (e.g., speeding fines)
- Exclusions: drivers with 6+ penalty points or DVLA-imposed medical restrictions
